### **BATTERY EXPERTS FORUM'S CONFERENCE PROGRAM RELEASED**

This November, the Battery Experts Forum will take place for the 18<sup>th</sup> time. It presents a top-class scientific conference with accompanying trade exhibition along the entire value chain of battery technology. The spectrum starts with cell manufacturers and suppliers of production machines for battery manufacturing, continues with suppliers of components and battery builders, and extends to testing institutes and end applications.
